### Play & Experience

You can have a lot of fun through a variety of adventures, like the forest playground and mountain bike trails, in the midst of magnificent nature. There are also interesting hands-on attractions, such as milking cows, feeding sheep, and horseback riding.



### View & Learn

You can marvel at the magnificent views to be found here, such as the 360-degree panorama of Fukuoka City from the Chuo Observation Deck, and the Shiranami Waterfalls with its impressive, flowing silvery ribbons of water. You can also have a learning opportunity at a nature center, which offers information through visual displays, such as the preserved mountain butterfly collection.



### Shop & Taste

There are several shopping and culinary outlets here, including Mori no Kiosk, selling snacks, drinks and original souvenirs, and the Cheese Stand, selling dairy products produced from the fresh milk of Aburayama Farm.



An area where you can indulge in several outdoor activities, like hiking and cycling, while enjoying the area's amazing array of natural features, including the scenic coastline




## Uminonakamichi Seaside Park ①

In this vast park, facing the Genkai Sea and Hakata Bay, colorful flowers bloom throughout the year, offering a world of stunning scenery. Surrounded by this beauty, visitors can enjoy a variety of activities, including horseback riding, e-scooters, Segway tours, and one of Japan's largest adventure playgrounds, "Sea Dragoon."

## Marine World Uminonakamichi ①

This aquarium has around 30,000 marine creatures from 350 species on display under the theme, the seas of Kyushu. Fun-filled attractions here include an exciting dolphin show and a massive tank that will allow you to feel as if you were actually in the ocean. It is thrilling to watch the huge sand tiger sharks and tens of thousands of sardines swimming in unison.



## Wajiro Tidal Flat

This is one of Japan's top stopover sites for migratory birds. In spring and autumn, you can observe the sandpipers and plovers that have traveled across the world to reach here, while in winter, a variety of birds, including ducks, can be seen.



## Shikanoshima Island ②

Since this island is connected to the mainland by a sandbar, it is easy enough to reach, or even to cycle around the just 10km of coastline. There are several popular spots to visit here, including Shikaumi Shrine where the god of marine transportation is enshrined, and Kin'in Park, where the *kin'in*, or gold seal, presented to Japan by what is now present-day China in the year 57 A.D. was discovered. The view from the observation point here is also quite amazing.




## Visitor Etiquette




Smoke in designated smoking areas only.
